# The Bronze Snake

Numbers 20–21

**Key Passage:** Proverbs 3:5

**Babies & Toddlers Christ Connection:**

We look to Jesus to save us and bring us back to God.

**Preschool Christ Connection:** When the Israelites sinned, God sent snakes to punish them. But anyone who was bitten by a snake could look at the bronze snake on the pole and live. We sin, too. Our sin keeps us from God. Anyone who looks to Jesus and trusts in Him is saved and has life with God forever.

**Big Picture Question & Answer:**

What does it mean to sin? To sin is to go against God and His commands.

**Story Point for Babies & Toddlers:**

We can trust God.

**Story Point for Preschoolers:** God told His people to look at the bronze snake.

- God did not leave His people when they complained.
- God healed His people.
